3 Witness for the PNGC Group

4 *Q: Please state your name, employer and business address.*

5 A: My name is R. Patrick Reiten. I am employed by Pacific Northwest Generating  
6 Cooperative (PNGC Power), 711 NE Halsey, Portland, Oregon 97232.

7 *Q: In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A: I am the President and Chief Executive Officer of PNGC Power. PNGC Power is  
9 a joint operating entity under Section 5(b)(7) of the Northwest Power Act. PNGC  
10 Power purchases wholesale power from BPA and resells it to its Members.  
11 PNGC Power provides wholesale power management, operations and other  
12 technical services to its Members, fifteen rural electric cooperatives who are  
13 preference customers of BPA.

14 *Q: Please state your educational background.*

15 A: I hold a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science from the University of  
16 Washington.

17 *Q: Please summarize your professional experience.*

18 A: I served as professional staff in the U.S. Senate for seven years, handling energy  
19 and natural resources matters for then-U.S. Senator Mark O. Hatfield. I worked  
20 for the U.S. Department of the Interior for approximately three years, last serving  
21 as Deputy Director of External Affairs for the Bureau of Land Management. I  
22 joined PNGC Power in 1993, serving, successively, as Director of Government

- 1 Relations, Vice President of Marketing and Public Affairs, and President and
- 2 CEO since 2002.
