## PETITION OF NORTHWEST REQUIREMENTS UTILITIES AND INDIVIDUALLY NAMED UTILITY MEMBERS TO INTERVENE AS PARTIES

Pursuant to the Federal Register Notice in this matter, 74 FR 6609 (February 10, 2009), and the Bonneville Power Administration's ("BPA") Procedures Governing BPA Rate Hearings, 51 FR 7611 (March 5, 1986), Northwest Requirements Utilities ("NRU") submits this Petition to Intervene as a Party in these matters on behalf of itself and on behalf of its individually named utility members identified in Attachment A to this Petition. In support of its Petition, NRU states the following:

1. NRU is a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the state of Oregon to represent the interests of its utility members in all power supply, transmission, contract, and rate matters respecting the Bonneville Power Administration ("BPA"). NRU's members are municipalities, public utility districts, peoples' utility districts, and rural electric cooperatives, all of which are located in BPA's statutory service area. As such, these utilities are "public body and cooperative" customers of BPA and are entitled to purchase power supplies from BPA on a preferential basis pursuant to section 5(b) of the

Pacific Northwest Electric Power Planning and Conservation Act. 16 U.S.C. § 839c(b).

2. NRU's utility members have a substantial interest in these BPA matters because

they pay power and transmission rates that will be affected by the proposal described in

the February 10, 2009, Federal Register notice. NRU's interest in this proceeding is thus

substantial; no other party may adequately represent NRU's or its member utilities'

interests.

3. NRU and the individually named utility members listed in Attachment A wish to

intervene as parties in BPA-10, and in both sub-dockets, WP-10 and TR-10.

4. Rule 1010.4(b) of BPA's Procedures state that Petitions to Intervene may name no

more than two persons on whom service of documents are to be made. As all filings in

BPA rate hearings are now conducted via BPA's secure website, NRU respectfully

requests waiver of Rule 1010.4, and further requests that Service of documents in these
