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**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF  
PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF SNOHOMISH COUNTY**

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Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County, Washington (“Snohomish”) respectfully petitions the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”) for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceedings pursuant to Rule 1010.4 of BPA’s Rules of Procedure Governing Rate Hearings and the Federal Register Notice published February 10, 2009 (74 Fed. Reg. 6609). In support of this Petition, Snohomish states:

Snohomish is a publicly-owned utility and municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington engaged in the retail distribution and sale of electric power and is a statutory preference customer of BPA. The mailing address of Snohomish’s principal place of business is: 2320 California Street, P.O. Box 1107, Everett, WA 98206-1107.

The above-captioned proceedings will adjust transmission and power rates BPA charges its preference customers (and others) for the purchase of transmission service and wholesale power beginning in Fiscal Year 2010 and continuing through the end of Fiscal Year 2011. As a statutory preference customer of BPA, and an electric utility which purchases the majority of its electric power from BPA, the rates paid by Snohomish are subject to adjustment in these

proceedings, and thus Snohomish has a direct and substantial interest in these proceedings and is entitled to intervene per Section 1010.4 of BPA's Rules of Procedure Governing Rate Hearings.
