Anna J. Miles

Q. Please state your name and address.

A. My name is Anna J. Miles. I am employed by Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County, Washington ("Snohomish"), located at 2320 California Street, Everett, Washington.

Q. In what capacity are you employed?

A. I am the Senior Manager of Snohomish's Power Supply Department in the Power, Rates and Transmission Management Division.

Q. Please summarize your educational experience.

A. I received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Economics and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration from Central Washington University, Ellensburg, Washington in 1985.

Q. Please summarize your relevant professional experience.

A. From June 1999 through July 2005 I held a variety of increasingly responsible positions at Puget Sound Energy in Bellevue, Washington, including managing 24x7 operations, day ahead and forward power marketing, and energy portfolio management. In July 2005 I joined Snohomish as Senior Manager of the Power Scheduling Department, where I was

1 responsible for managing Snohomish's short-term power supply portfolio and 24x7
2 operations, including management of the Slice contract. In October 2007 I was promoted
3 to Senior Manager of the Power Supply Department, where I am responsible for
4 managing Snohomish's long-term power supply and resource acquisitions.

5 *Q. Please state your experience in previous Bonneville Power Administration proceedings.*

6 A. I submitted testimony for Snohomish regarding integration of wind resources and
7 accurate forecasting of reserves in the BPA-10 proceeding, where Bonneville set rates for
8 transmission and wholesale power service for fiscal years 2010-2011.
