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5 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

6 A. My name is Kelly Johnson. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration  
7 (BPA), 7500 NE 41st Street, Suite 130, Vancouver, Washington.

8 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

9 A. I am a Supervisory Electrical Engineer in Transmission Services and the Manager of the  
10 Customer Service Engineering organization.

11 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

12 A. I received a Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering (BSEE) from the  
13 University of Portland in 1984.

14 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

15 A. I was an officer in the United States Air Force from 1984–1989. In 1990, I started with  
16 BPA as a field construction and test engineer. I worked on every aspect of the  
17 transmission grid, constructing and commissioning new and replacement equipment.  
18 In 1995, after temporary assignments in design and budget, I moved to the Customer  
19 Service Engineering organization. I was assigned to coordinate transmission plans of  
20 service with utility customers located primarily in the Portland-Vancouver area. In  
21 2007, I became manager of the Customer Service Engineering organization. We are  
22 responsible for, among other things, generation and line/load interconnections to the  
23 Federal Columbia River Transmission System. I am personally responsible for direct  
24 assignment recommendations and determinations. My organization is also responsible  
25 for the Customer Service Reliability Program and, as such, works extensively with the  
26 Western Electricity Coordinating Council and Peak, the regional reliability coordinator.
