**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF  
EDP RENEWABLES NORTH AMERICA LLC**

EDP Renewables North America LLC (EDPRNA) on behalf of itself and certain subsidiaries, files this Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned matter as a party with full rights pursuant to Rule 1010.6 of the Rules of Procedure of Bonneville Power Administration (Bonneville) governing rate hearings and the December 6, 2018 *Federal Register* notice published at 83 Fed. Reg. 62,845. EDPRNA respectfully requests that it be granted full party status in Bonneville Docket No. TC-20, including any related sub-dockets (Proceeding). In support of this Petition, EDPRNA submits the following information:

**I. Petition to Intervene**

EDPRNA and its subsidiaries, Arlington Wind Power Project LLC (Arlington), Sagebrush Power Partners, LLC (Sagebrush) and Wheat Field Wind Power Project LLC (Wheat Field) are long-term transmission customers under Bonneville’s Open Access Transmission Tariff. Each of EDPRNA, Arlington, Sagebrush and Wheat Field has a transmission service contract with Bonneville that will be affected by the Proceeding.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Specifically, the four affected contracts for transmission service with Bonneville are EDPRNA (Contract No. 07TX-12892), Arlington (Contract No. 07TX-12526), Sagebrush (Contract No. 11TX-15454), and Wheat Field (Contract No. 08TX-13610).

Further, EDPRNA, Arlington, Sagebrush and Wheat Field were participants in and are signatories to the Bonneville TC-20 settlement proceeding that is the basis for the instant Proceeding.

Accordingly, EDPRNA has a direct and substantial interest in the outcome of this Proceeding that cannot be adequately represented by any other party. Therefore, EDPRNA respectfully requests leave to intervene in this Proceeding and participate as a party with full rights.
