5 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

6 A. My name is John D. Stalnakar, Jr. I am employed by the Bonneville Power
7 Administration (BPA), 905 NE 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

8 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

9 A. I am a Public Utilities Specialist in the Residential Exchange Program (REP) department
10 of Northwest Requirements Marketing.

11 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

12 A. I received a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice from Columbia Southern
13 University in 2010 and a Master of Business Administration degree with a specialization
14 in Public Administration from the same institution in 2014.

15 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

16 A. In June 2013, I was hired by BPA into the Pathways Internship program while
17 completing my graduate studies. Upon graduation in June 2014, I was offered a
18 permanent position in the REP department of Northwest Requirements marketing, where
19 I have remained for the duration of my employment at BPA.

20 In the REP group I serve as an analyst calculating the Average System Cost
21 (ASC) of participating utilities. I also currently serve as the technical lead for all
22 analysis in the REP program, including oversight of forecasting both in the ASC process
23 and long-term.

24 Additionally, I oversee two models (and their subsequent calculations) that fall
25 under the responsibility of the Power Rates department of Northwest Requirements

1 Marketing, including the Resource Support Services (RSS) model and the Generation
2 and Reserves Dispatch (GARD) model.

3 *Q. Please state your experience as a witness in previous proceedings.*

4 *A. I have not previously served as a witness in any rate case proceedings.*
