**PETITION FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE  
BY THE WESTERN PUBLIC AGENCIES GROUP**

Pursuant to the Federal Register Notice published on December 1, 2020, 85 Fed. Reg. 77,189 (2020) and the Bonneville Power Administration’s Rules of Procedure, 83 Fed Reg. 39,9993 (2018), each of the utilities that comprise the Western Public Agencies Group (“WPAG”)<sup>1</sup> hereby individually file this Petition for Leave to Intervene in the above captioned matter each as a party of right. In support of this Petition, the following information is provided.

**I.**

Each of the utilities that comprise WPAG currently purchases wholesale power and transmission services from the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”) under rates that will be affected by the proposed adjustments, and will continue to do so during the period when the rates that will be established in this proceeding are in effect.

**II.**

The rates that each of the WPAG utilities will pay to BPA for wholesale power and transmission services will be established in the above captioned proceeding, and this will directly affect the end-use consumers served by the WPAG utilities. No other party to this proceeding will adequately represent the interests of each of the WPAG utilities.
