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6 **Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.**

7 **A.** My name is Henry Tilghman. I am the Principal of Tilghman Associates, a
8 consulting firm in Portland, OR.

9 **Q. For whom are you testifying in this proceeding?**

10 **A.** I am testifying on behalf of Renewable Northwest and the Northwest &
11 Intermountain Power Producers Coalition.

12 **Q. Have you previously testified in a Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”)**
13 **rate case?**

14 **A.** No.

15 **Q. Have you previously testified before state regulatory commissions?**

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1 Q. Yes. I have testified on renewable energy and transmission-related issues before
2 the state utility commission of Maine.

3 A. **What is your background and educational experience?**

4 Q. I have a Bachelor of Science degree from Georgetown University and a Juris
5 Doctor *cum laude* from the Northwestern School of Law at Lewis & Clark
6 College with a certificate in Environmental Law. Since 2009, I have been self-
7 employed as a consultant on energy issues, primarily related to renewable energy
8 development, transmission planning, and energy market design. Past projects
9 include: supporting generation developers in rate cases and rulemaking
10 proceedings; supporting trade organizations in policy development and
11 stakeholder processes; advising an offshore energy trade group on policy issues;
12 representing wind and solar developers in various stakeholder proceedings in the
13 West and Pacific Northwest (including BPA and ColumbiaGrid); advising wind
14 and solar developers and investors on public policy developments and resulting
15 market impacts; representing project developers in public stakeholder processes
16 related to energy market design and transmission planning processes; serving as a
17 member of the Environmental Data Task Force (creating a process to collect west-
18 wide environmental data for use in planning and high-level siting of transmission
19 lines); expert testimony in support of transmission infrastructure development;
20 supporting wind and solar developers with transmission strategies,
21 interconnection processes and transmission service requests. Previous
22 employment includes directing the government relations team at a manufacturer
23 of utility-scale wind turbines, serving as an attorney at BPA supporting the

- 1 Transmission Business Line, and providing regulatory and policy support to the
- 2 trading floor of an electric utility.
