**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF
PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF SNOHOMISH COUNTY**

Public Utility District No. 1 of Snohomish County, Washington (“Snohomish”), respectfully petitions for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to section 1010.6 of the Bonneville Power Administration’s (“BPA”) Rules of Procedure governing rate hearings and the Federal Register Notice published November 13, 2024 (89 Fed. Reg. 89627). In support of this Petition, Snohomish states:

Snohomish is a consumer-owned utility and a municipal corporation of the state of Washington formed by a majority vote of the people for the purpose of providing electric and/or water utility service. Snohomish is a statutory preference customer of BPA, purchases approximately 80% of its electric energy from BPA, and purchases transmission, ancillary, and generator interconnection services from BPA pursuant to the terms and conditions of the BPA Open Access Transmission Tariff. Therefore, Snohomish is entitled to intervene in this proceeding pursuant to section 1010.6(b) of BPA’s Rules of Procedure governing rate hearings.
