**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF  
PACIFIC NORTHWEST GENERATING COOPERATIVE**

Pursuant to the Federal Register notice, 89 Fed. Reg. 89,622 (November 13, 2024), regarding the Bonneville Power Administration (“BPA”) Proposed Modifications to Open Access Transmission Tariff; Public Hearing and Opportunities for Public Review and Comment, and Section 1010.6 of BPA’s 2018 Rules of Procedure, Pacific Northwest Generating Cooperative d/b/a PNGC Power (“PNGC Power”) hereby petitions for leave to intervene as a party in the above-captioned proceeding.

PNGC Power is a cooperative corporation organized under the laws of the State of Oregon and a Joint Operating Entity pursuant to the Northwest Power Act, 16 USC § 839c(b)(7). PNGC Power currently directly purchases wholesale power and transmission services from BPA to meet the requirements of sixteen (16) distribution cooperative members. By FY 2029, PNGC will directly purchase wholesale power and transmission services from BPA to meet the requirements of an additional nine (9) distribution cooperative members, making it the largest federal preference power customer of BPA. The non-rate terms and conditions across the Federal Columbia River Transmission System are included within the BPA Open Access Transmission Tariff. This proceeding modifies such non-rate terms and conditions. In this proceeding BPA proposes to adopt, effective October 1, 2025, modifications to the non-rate Tariff terms and conditions consistent with the Tariff attached to a proposed TC–26 Settlement Agreement. Accordingly, PNGC Power has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding. PNGC Power’s interests will not be adequately represented by any other party.
