I. PETITION TO INTERVENE

On November 13, 2024, BPA published the Federal Register Notice regarding the Fiscal Year 2029 Public Rate Design Methodology, designated as Docket No. PRDM-26.

PSE is a corporation created and organized under the laws of the State of Washington with its principal office in Bellevue, Washington. PSE is an investor-owned utility engaged in, among other things, the business of generating, transmitting, and distributing electric power to wholesale and retail customers in the State of Washington. PSE is a customer of BPA. PSE can also contract directly with BPA for the purchase of power under sections 5(b) or 5(c) of the Northwest Power Act. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 1010.6(b) of BPA's Rules of Procedure, PSE has an interest in this proceeding and is eligible to be a party in this proceeding.
