**Petition to Intervene of Avista

Pursuant to Section 1010.6 of the Bonneville Power Administration's ("BPA") Rules of Procedure and the notice posted in the Federal Register on November 13, 2024,¹ Avista Corporation ("Avista") hereby files this Petition to Intervene as a party in these proceedings. Avista requests that it be granted party status in BPA Docket No. PRDM-26, including any subdockets to that proceeding.

I. Petition to Intervene

BPA is holding a proceeding, Docket No. TC-25, to modify the non-rate terms and conditions for transmission and interconnection services in its open access transmission tariff.

Avista is a corporation created and organized under the laws of the State of Washington, with its principal office at 1411 E. Mission Ave., Spokane, Washington. Avista is an investor-owned utility engaged in among other things, the business of generating, transmitting, and distributing electric power to wholesale and retail customers in Idaho and Washington.
