**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF
THE CITY OF TACOMA,
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES, POWER DIVISION**

Pursuant to Section 1010.6 of the Rules of Procedure of the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA or Bonneville) and the Federal Register Notice dated November 13, 2024 (89 Fed. Reg. 89,622), the City of Tacoma, Department of Public Utilities, Power Division (“Tacoma”) hereby petitions for leave to intervene as a party in the above-captioned proceeding.

The City of Tacoma, Department of Public Utilities, Power Division (“Tacoma”) is a publicly owned utility operating in the State of Washington for over 125 years. Tacoma serves over 183,000 customers within the city of Tacoma and across neighboring cities and in unincorporated Pierce County, Washington. Tacoma is governed by a five-member Public Utility Board, together with the elected Tacoma City Council. Tacoma purchases power, transmission, and certain ancillary services from BPA at the rates set by BPA in its rate proceedings.

Pursuant to Section 1010.6(b) of BPA’s Rules of Procedure, “[e]ntities that directly purchase power or transmission services under Bonneville’s rate schedules, or trade organizations representing those entities, will be granted intervention, based on a petition filed in conformity with this Section 1010.6.” Tacoma is a public power customer of BPA within the

meaning of Section 1010.6(b) and has a direct and substantial interest in participating in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party.

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Wherefore, Tacoma requests that this petition to intervene be granted and Tacoma be made a formal party to this proceeding.
