PNGC Power (PNGC) hereby provides notice to all parties in the PRDM proceeding, of its desire to initiate a settlement discussion with the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) regarding the Joint Operating Entity (JOE) and RICj issues as addressed in PNGC's testimony, PRDM-26-E-PN-01, and BPA's rebuttal testimony, PRDM-26-E-BPA-11.

After careful consideration of BPA's rebuttal testimony, PNGC believes there is an opportunity to resolve several of the areas of disagreement and lay a foundation for a more productive working relationship that delivers mutual benefits to both PNGC and BPA during the Provider of Choice contract period to which the PRDM will apply.
